# A. Types of Funding Mechanisms

- 1. Grant: non-repayable financial assistance offered by a funder to a recipient to implement a given project
- 2. Contract: a legal arrangement where one party purchases property or services needed to carry out the project (or given activities) on its behalf
- 3. Cooperative Agreements: a funding arrangement that provides for substantial involvement of the donor in the funded project
- 4. Scholarships: a grant or payment made to support a student's education
- 5. Prizes: funding given as a reward to the winner of a competition or in recognition of an outstanding achievement



### B. What is a Funding Opportunity?


A publicly available document by which a Donor Agency publishes its intentions to award grants, usually as a result of competition for funds.



Funding opportunity announcements can also be known as program announcements/requests for applications/notices of funding availability/solicitations
